Today, case was fixed for filing RC/AD. RC/AD dated 08.10.2024 placed on record by the Ld. Counsel of complainant. None present on behalf of accused. Ld. Counsel of complainant orally requested to proceed the case as per law as due opportunity before taking cognizance as per Section 223(1) of BNSS 2023 was granted and accused failed to put his appearance before the Court. Request heard. Perusal of the file reveals that vide order dated 08.08.2024 pre cognizance notice was directed by this Court and same was complied with by the Ld. Counsel of complainant.
