Considering the nature of offence, accused No.2 is admitted to bail upon furnishing his personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with a surety in like amount. Personal bond furnished, same is accepted till the next date of hearing. Accused undertake to produce surety on the next date of hearing. Accused No.2 is directed to appear in person on the next date.
