On the last date of hearing plaintiff was directed to file the original postal receipts, however, none has been filed.

Issue fresh summons for settlement of issues to the defendant on filing of PF/RC as well as through Speed Post, returnable for the next date of hearing. Plaintiff is directed to bring the tracking report of RC and Speed Post along with an affidavit, on the next date of hearing. Process server is directed to serve the summons by way of affixation. Let steps be taken within seven days by the plaintiff.

The process server is directed to serve summons strictly as per the provisions of Order 5 Rule 17 of Code of Civil Procedure. If there is refusal on behalf of defendant to accept the summons, the process server is directed to effect the service by way of affixation. If the process server comes to know that the defendant has shifted from the given address, the process server would try from the neighbours of the locality to ascertain the fresh/new address where the defendant has shifted and served summons to the defendant on such address. If the process server after due diligence is not able to find the address at which the defendant has started residing after shifting from the given address, the process server is directed to effect the service of the summons by way of affixation on the address on which the summons has been sent. Herein above direction be specifically mentioned on the summons.
