The case of the plaintiff in the present suit is that the height of the space for which the electricity meter is required is less than 15 meters. To support its claim, the plaintiff has placed on record the height certificate from a registered engineer certifying that the height of the building is less than 15 meters.

On the other hand the contention of the defendant is that the premises for which the electricity connection is being sought is having height of more than 15 meters and therefore electricity connection cannot be granted unless there is a fire clearance certificate from the concerned agency/ authority.

In these circumstances, the defendant is required to file a certificate from a qualified engineer of the BSES in support of its contention that the height of the building is more than 15 meters.
