Summons issued to the witnesses received back as served. They have appeared.

CW5 has been examined. The counsels for the accused persons chose to not cross examine the witness. The witness is discharged. Diet money be paid to him. The document which was sought to be produced by the witness is not traceable. The copy is placed on record. Since CW5 has submitted that the record may have been burned, the ld. counsel for the complainant submits that Ex. CW1/C filed in pre summoning evidence be read as secondary evidence. The counsel for the accused persons are directed to address arguments on this aspect. The admissibility of this document is still pending and shall be decided after conclusion of arguments on this point.

CW6 examined, cross examined and discharged. Diet money be paid to the witness. The counsels for the accused persons are at liberty to address arguments on admissibility of Ex. CW3/J (Colly) and Ex. CW6/A (colly).

CW7 examined, cross examined and discharged. Diet money be paid to the witness.

CW8 partly examined in chief. Further examination is deferred as the witness is questioned why blanks are maintained in a register which is to be maintained chronologically. The witness seeks

adjournment to furnish clarifications after seeking the same from the concerned Sub Registrar.
