ISSUES

Sanjay Pandit respondent no. 1 and owned by Sh. Brijesh Kumar respondent no. 2 due to which Vijay Kumar had passed away? ...OPP

2. Whether the petitioners in the above mentioned case are entitled to claim compensation, if so, what amount and from whom? ... OPP

3. Relief.
