ORDER ON I.A.IV

- 1. The plaintiff counsel has filed the present I.A. seeking police protection with respect to the suit schedule property measuring to the extant of 04-acres, 04-guntas situated at Village Ucha, Tq.Bhalki.
- 2. The defendant counsel has filed objections contending that, the I.A. filed by the plaintiff seeking police protection is not maintainable, as the defendant has preferred M.A. No.2/2022 before the Hon'ble Senior Civil Judge, Bhalki, which is pending for consideration.

Heard both sides.

- 3. The following points arise for consideration.
 - Point No.1:- Whether the plaintiff has made out prima-facie ground to grant police protection?

Point No.2:- What order?

REASONS

4. **Point No.1:**- The plaintiff counsel has filed the suit against the defendants for the relief of perpetual

injunction. The counsel has filed I.A.No.I U/o.39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C., the defendants counsel has filed objections to the I.A. The I.A.No.I filed by the plaintiff was disposed on 29-06-2022. The court after hearing both the sides and on merit has passed an order, restraining the defendants from interfering in the possession of plaintiff over the suit schedule property till the disposal of this suit. Hence, I answered point No.1 in the "Affirmative".

5. **Point No.2:**- as per the following.....

ORDER

The P.S.I. of Khataka Chincholi police station is hereby directed to provide police protection to the plaintiff, if the defendants tries to interfere in the possession of plaintiff over the suit schedule property.
