

### **ORDERS ON I.A.NO.IV**

The Counsel for plaintiffs filed the present application under Order VII Rule 14(3) and Section 151 of C.P.C. to receive the documents accompanying with Affidavit duly sworn by the 2<sup>nd</sup> plaintiff.

On the other hand, the counsel for defendants filed objections denying the contents of Affidavit averments as not maintainable both at law and points of facts.

Heard both sides and perused the materials placed before me.

The plaintiffs have filed the present suit seeking partition over plaint schedule 'A' property.
