ORDERS ON APPLICATION FILED
UNDER SECTION 91 CRPC DATED
24.08.2024 BY THE COMPLAINANT

The learned counsel appearing for complainant has filed an application under Section 91 of Cr.P.C to produce the payment receipt, sale agreement. Further he submits that the documents which are sought to be produced are very much necessary to prove the case of the complainant which are admitted by the complainant and thereby prays to allow the application.

Per contra the learned counsel appearing for accused filed his objection and submits that the said application is false, frivolous and not maintainable either in law or on facts. These documents are concocted documents and not at all pertaining to the present case and thereby prays to dismiss the same.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsels appearing for the both the parties the document which is

sought to be produced prima-faciely appears to be a necessary document and hence in order to avoid multiplicity of the proceedings and to arrive at just decision of the case it is necessary to allow the application. Hence this court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

Application filed by the complainant under section 91 of CrPC is hereby allowed.
