ORDERS ON IA NO.I

This petition is filed by the petitioners under section 125(1) of Cr.P.C., seeking compensation and monthly maintenence from the respondent and such other consequential reliefs.

- **2)** Along with the petition, the petitioners have filed IA No.I under section 125(1) of Cr.P.C., seeking interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/-per month to petitioners till disposal of the petition.
- **3)** Perused the petition, IA No.I, affidavit and the documents produced along with the petition. On verification of the same the allegation of cruelty, etc meted out to the petitioners by the respondent is a matter of trial and the same is kept open at this stage. On the other hand, sufficient materials are produced at this point of time to show that the Petitioner No.1 is the wife and Petitioner No.2 and 3 are the children of respondent. It is further stated that, the respondent is economically sound, hail and capable to maintain the petitioners. Considering these facts, this court is of the opinion that the petitioners have made out grounds for consideration at this stage to pass necessary order against the respondent for payment of maintenence. But the quantum of maintenance amount is fixed at Rs.2,000/- each per month to the petitioners. Accordingly, this court proceed to pass the following:

::ORDER::

• Pending disposal of the above application for interim maintainance, the respondent is hereby directed to pay a sum of Rs.2,000/- each per month to petitioners No.1 to 3

towards their maintenance.
