- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit-properties are the ancestral-properties of himself and defendants?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit-properties have been in joint-possession of himself and defendants?
- 3) Whether defendant no.1 to 3 prove that the plaintiff has relinquished his share in the suit-item no.1 by virtue of the Registered Relinquishment Deed dated 20.5.2019 as contended in para-12 of written statement?
- 4) Whether defendant no.1 to 3 prove that suit-item no.2 and 3 are the self-acquired properties of defendant no.1?
- 5) Whether defendant no.4 proves that he is the bonafide- purchaser of suit-item no.1?
- 6) Whether defendant no.4 proves that the suit is bad for partial-partition?
- 7) Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed?
- 8) What order or decree?
