ORDER

1 This order of the court will dispose of an application filed by the applicant no. 1/defendant no. 1 for issuing necessary direction to the respondent/plaintiff to provide the complete copy of plaint and documents annexed thereto to the defendant no.1.

2. Brief facts of the application are that case was fixed for filing the written statement by the applicant no.1/defendant no.1. Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 1 appeared on behalf of defendant no. 1 on 28.01.2025. However, the counsel for defendant no. 1 orally requested the plaintiff's counsel many times to supply the copy of plaint as well as documents annexed thereto but the same was not supplied till date. It is further contended that in the the absence of aforesaid plaint as well as documents annexed with the plaint the defendant no.1 is unable to file appropriate written statement. Hence this present application.

Accordingly, in order to enable the applicant no.1/defendant no. 1 to put his defence effectively, plaintiff is directed to supply the copy of documents to the applicant no.1/defendant no.1. Accordingly, the present application stands allowed.
