- 4. Whether the plaintiff has not come to the court with clean hands and has concealed the true and material facts from court? OPD.
- 5. Whether the plaintiff has got no locus standi and cause of action to file the present suit? OPD

6. Relief

No other issue arises nor pressed. Now to come upon 11.09.2024 for evidence of plaintiff. List of witnesses along with PF/DM be also filed within 7 days. The Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff is further directed to supply advance copy of affidavit of the witnesses, if any to the counsel for the defendants 5 days prior to the date fixed for evidence, so that the cross-examination of the witness can be done on the same date.
