Now I am residing at Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. I am working as Deputy Manager, State Bank of India, Retail Asset Clearance Cell, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. On 06.03.2019, I was working as Deputy Manager/Branch Manager, SBI, AGCR Building Branch, New Delhi, in response to the letter of Superintendent of Police, CBI, ACB, Chennai, dated 28.02.2019, I submitted the following documents along with the covering letter.

1. The Computer extract of statement of account no.31178109517 of Shri.A.Paramasivan, from 01.01.2010 to 22.04.2014 along with certificate u/s.2B of Bankers Books of Evidence Act, 1891, issued by me on 06.03.2019.

The covering letter and above said documents bears my signature and seal, which was already marked as Ex.P.100/L.D.95 (83 sheets).

As per statement of account as on 29.05.2010, balance amount available in the said account was Rs.23,600/- (Rupees Twenty Three Thousand Six Hundred Only) and Balance available on 22.04.2014 was Rs.14,465.24/-(Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred and Sixty Five Rupees and Twenty Four Paise Only). For the period of 01.01.2010 to 22.04.2014, a sum of Rs.997/- (Rupees Nine Hundred and Ninety Seven Only) was credited as interest and Rs.800/-(Rupees Eight Hundred Only) was debited as bank charges during the said period.
