### **Cross Examination of A1:**

Yes it is correct to state that for every Leave Travel concession, there should be an application and the same will be sanctioned and entered in the Service Register. Yes it is correct to state that for availing the LTC, a Government servant has to submit LTC Bill for claiming the amount. Yes it is correct to state that it is not the extract of the record but we have submitted the report based on the records available in our 3

office. I deny the suggestion that I am not the competent person to state about the record.
